We hereby confirm that all Plastobarr, Plastofresh, Taribo, Multiform, Toplex, Hotlam, Plastolam, Plaskin, Plastogold and Plastomatt films and bags-pouches, plain, colored and printed - manufactured by PLASTOPIL are covered by the following regulations: -

FDA

All of the raw materials used in the making of the films are approved for food contact according to the FDA/USDA standards by the material manufacturers and comply with the requirements set forth in FDA/USDA regulations 21 CFR section 177.1520 (Polyethylene), 177.1360 (EVOH), 175.105 (Adhesives), 177.1500 (Polyamide), and 177.1330 (Ionomer), 177.1350 (EVA), 177.1570 (Polybutylene).

All of the raw materials used in the making of the films conform to REGULATION (EC) No. 1935/2004 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT and 2004/19/CE directive and directive 2002/72/EC, official journal of the EC. No. 175/22 and amendments up to 2002/17/EC, directive 2007/19/EC, directive 2008/39/EC (no wax) and EU directive 94/62/EC (Packaging Waste), Regulation (EC) No: 2023/2006.


All of the raw materials used in the making of the films conform to the following:-
