

**COMPLIANCE WITH FOOD CONTACT LEGISLATION:** We certify that the above products are manufactured to comply with the following legal requirements and meet the minimum legal requirements in the country of manufacture:

- The **Regulation (EC) No. 1935/2004** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 October 2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and amendment EU2020/1245.
- The **Commission Regulation (EC) No. 10/2011** and all successive amendments including **2016/1416; 2017/752; 2018/79; 2018/213; 2018/831**
- **Regulation (EC) No. 2023/2006**
- The **Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1895/2005** of 18 November 2005 on the restriction of use of certain epoxy derivatives in materials and articles intended to come into contact with food
- The **Materials and Articles in Contact with Food (England) Regulations 2012**
- The **Food Safety and Hygiene (England) Regulations 2013**

**COMPLIANCE WITH MIGRATION TESTING:** The materials have been tested in accordance with the requirements of EC 10/2011 with regards to overall migration limits. Overall migration limits are within the specified limit of 10mg per 1 dm<sup>2</sup> for a cubic packaging containing 1kg of food to a migration of 60mg per kg of food.

**HEAVY METALS:** Our suppliers state that cadmium, chromium (hexavalent), mercury and lead are not intentionally added during product manufacture. Any incidental amounts would not exceed 100 ppm by weight.

1. All goods must be on 4 way pallets not more than 5ft. high. 2. Order Number to be quoted on all invoices and delivery notes. 3. No goods to be invoiced at price ABOVE those shown without confirmation. 4. Delivery dates must be adhered to otherwise goods may not be accepted.

**BADGE/BFDGE/NOGE:** Our suppliers state that epoxy resins used during manufacture are approved and comply with the Union List of Authorised Substances EC 10/2011 and EC 1895/2005

**ALLERGENS:** Our suppliers state that the current list of 14 known allergens are not intentionally added during product manufacture

**REACH/SVHC:** Our suppliers state that substances (as listed on the EU Candidate Lists) are not intentionally added during product manufacture and are regularly reviewed for compliance to include 15<sup>th</sup> January 2018 update.

The above-mentioned product is intended for direct food contact; however, it is the responsibility of the user to verify its suitability for his intended food application.
