#### <u>Gloves</u>

Gloves must be marked with the size indication based on the size of the hand they are to cover, or with the coded color band appropriate to the glove size indicated in prospectus A.I. The prospectus A.2 provides the traditional glove sizes that correspond to the color of gloves encoded in prospectus A.1. Gloves that do not match the dimensions of the prospectus A.I must not be equipped with bands with these colors. Appendix B contains information on hand measurements and glove sizes that fit different hand sizes.

#### Flat Gloves

Six sizes of flat type gloves have been designated by contrad-band bands distinguished by different colors. The A.1 perspective shows the value and tolerance for each dimension of each glove size. The size of the gloves is measured with the help of finger gauges. The glove finger gauges have parallel sides and a rounded end as shown in Figure A.2 so that they can be inserted into the glove finger. They consist of sheets of 1 mm thickness with widths corresponding to the values from b, to above as indicated in prospectus A.3. The gauges are used by introducing them gently into the corresponding finger and measuring the length of the gauge inserted in relation to the corresponding indications given in Figure A.1.
